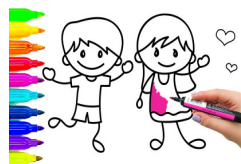

I was thinking

Dear Fellow Traveller,

October for some reason is a busy old month. Farmers gather in the harvest, there are jobs to be done in readiness for winter, garden to be tidied, bits of maintenance to be done with the house, central heating to be sorted out, summer clothes to be put away and the winter wool-lies brought to the fore, flu injection to be sorted out and so on. The cycle of life goes on and we need to be involved in it, taking one day at a time and doing the best we can with it.

During the past week our beloved Minister for Finance produced "The Budget". It has been described as "a little for everybody". Life is about choices and decisions. Sometimes we make good choices and sometimes not to good. Decisions effect us personally and often there is a community aspect to them - **our decisions effect others** - John Donne's well known poem puts it well:

*"No man is an island entire unto themselves"
Every man is a piece of the continent,
A part of the main.*

If a clod be washed away by the sea, Europe is the less.

As well as if a promontory were.

As well as if a manor of thy friend's or of thine own were:

The Pope in his book "On Love in the Family" says:

"There is also a general feeling of powerlessness in the face of socio cultural realities that oftentimes end up crushing families...Families often feel abandoned due to lack of interest and attention on the part of the institutions. The negative impact on the social order is clear, as seen in the demographic crisis, in the difficulty of raising children, in a hesitancy to welcome new life, in a tendency to see older persons as a burden and in an increase of emotional problems and outbreaks of violence. The state has the responsibility to pass laws and create work to ensure the future of young people and help them realise their plan of forming families".
