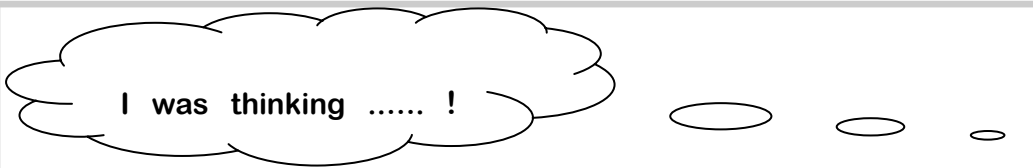
are launching new exercise programme called **'Men on the Move'**.

Dear Fellow Traveller,

Every time you walk the Salthill Prom it is beautiful in a different way. It can take us out of ourselves to see the dogs chasing the seagulls, and parents and their children on the beach looking at the waves, or to notice how parts of the Clare coast sometimes become clear and colourful. The birds bring their own attraction, with the cormorants drying their wings, or a lanky heron swooping to land with precision on a rock, or the busy oyster catchers darting around as they feed at the water's edge. In the evening the people on the diving board at Blackrock appear in silhouette, and on the way back the setting sun casts a golden light on everything. Then there is the fascination that comes from people watching, and hearing different languages, and from the moods of the ocean and the patterns of the clouds, and the smell of the seaweed and the salty taste of the sea spray.

A walk on the prom can help our spirit to soar. Scholars tell us that we can come to God through what is True, what is Good and what is Beautiful. The poet Seamus Heaney wrote a poem about a Sunday afternoon drive in the Burren, called *The Flaggy Shore*, where at the start he was 'neither here nor there', until suddenly the beauty of a scene before him had the ability to come at him *'sideways, and catch the heart of guard and blow it open'*.
