Non shed members welcome.

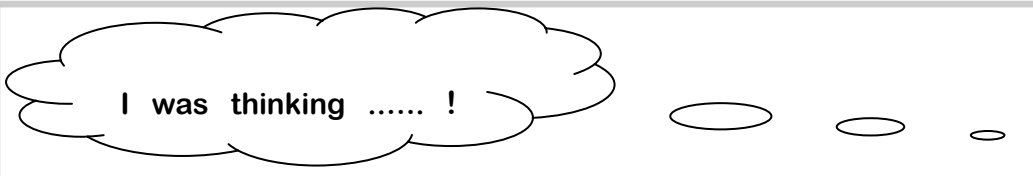
You will be coached by a qualified sports person and your progress mapped out for you. We pick some ideal time in morning or afternoon to begin.

I'm originally from Galway city but have always got a great atmosphere in your church when I visit Galway.

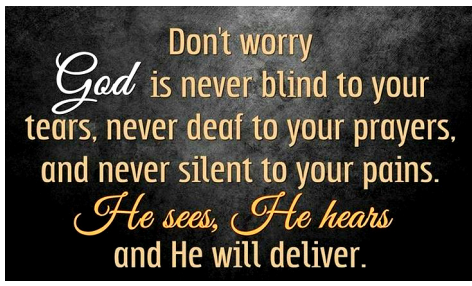
Thanks once again and God bless you in your work and that of all your parishioners.
