## From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Fellow Traveller,

With the “goings on” in Britain following the result of the Election, Trump tweets in USA, the threat of ongoing terrorism, Brexit, our little green isle having a new Taoiseach etc., we are undoubtedly living in rapidly changing and uncertain times. There is a glaring need to examine the principles by which our lives are ordered and to establish/re-inforce the basic values by which we run our lives.

One such issue our country will be tackling soon whether we like it or not is the issue of “the right to life of the unborn”, followed by the issue at the other end of the spectrum namely, “Euthanasia”. Some politicians along with international campaigners, want for example, to repeal the 8th Amendment. Our constitution as it stands says that both mother and baby have a right to life, and that both lives should be protected. Ultimately the argument is around “When does human life begin/end?”

Science tells us that our life started at conception — the moment when our sex, eye colour, potential height and even personality traits were determined. From that moment on we grew and developed. We were all once a “foetus” (which is the Latin term for ‘offspring or young one’), just as we were once an infant, a toddler, a teenager.
