I was thinking



Dear Fellow Traveller,

We live in an age of vitamins and supplements - we are bombarded daily with adds for health foods of all sorts, some mainstream others alternative. Some have "no added sugar", some contained vitamins "A to Z", "Omega 3,5,7", others "containing some "magic" ingredient from ancient China or a derivative from the small intestine of the "yellow fu fu fish found only of some far away Pacific island", - you name it it is out there, all promising "renewed vitality", extra "Mojo" and "you just are not living if you are not into it" !.

Today we mark the Feast of Corpus Christi (means Body of Christ). [The word "Corpus" meaning "body" - thus we have the word "Corporate", "Corporation" etc]. At the last supper Jesus took Bread and Wine, blessed them, and gave them to the disciples and said "Do this often in Memory of me". He did this so that we may have Life, and have it to the full. Each time we receive Holy Communion we come "into communion" with Christ in a unique and special way and are bound more closely to him. Shortly before we come to communion we say "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us" which put us in a position to accept his invitation. We come to receive at the Lord's table not because we are worthy but because he has invited us and we need his strength and his healing and sustaining grace. Receiving Communion often makes us better people, thus better able to handle the stresses and issues of our lives.



While I am on the subject of Holy Communion can I renew how best to receive the host - most people receive in the hand — placing the left hand over the right hand as making a cradle for God. Secondly, we stand as we receive the host denoting we came as "free persons not slaves having been redeemed by Christ". Parents are asked to guide those who recently receive their First Holy Communion as to best practice. (People may still receive the host on the tongue if that is their custom). Huge "Thank You" to all who help with Communion both in church, nursing homes and houses.
