Dear Fellow Traveller,

Just thinking about how much I take for granted. Recently I learned of a man I know who receive a kidney from a family member that has totally changed his life. What a wonderful thing a human kidney is. The heart gets all the publicity when really it is primarily a rubbery pump. The kidney on the other hand is miraculously complex and sophisticated reprocessing machine. Every day our kidneys filters something like 400 pints of blood, shifting out toxic and waste products and sending them on to our bladder for disposal. Our kidneys measure out the chemicals we need and release them back into the blood. As if that is not enough, they release the hormones that make our red blood cells, control our blood pressure and make vitamin D, which helps to maintain calcium for our bones. We have no trouble in saying **"I love you with all my heart"** - how about saying **"I love you with all my kidneys"** and see what reaction we get ! We take so much for granted - Thanks be to God !
