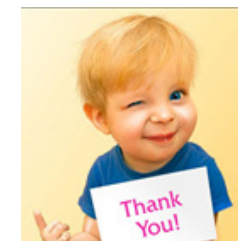

I was thinking !!

Dear Fellow Traveller,

Received this letter from a young parishioner:

Dear Salthill Parish,

I am a 23 year old man working in I.T. on the Tuam Rd and I live with two other guys in an apartment behind Seapoint. I would very much like to go to see (and hear) the Pope when he comes to Ireland at the end of August. I was baptised and confirmed in my home parish in Offaly but in recent years I don't go to Mass except at Christmas and Easter. As I grew up I heard my father and my Grandfather telling me about major events in their lives. My Grandfather talked about being at the Eucharistic Congress when over one million people assembled for the Final Mass in the Phoenix Park in 1932. He talked about the atmosphere and the feeling of communality with the wider world. My father was in Galway in 1979 when Pope John Paul visited Ireland and he still talks about a great "Coming together of goodness feeling" Old age, arthritis and a bad back prevents him from making the journey to see the Pope this time but he wishes he could be there. Mom and Dad now go to church sparingly but they both talk with great enthusiasm about that special day.

Thinking about it, I would like to be able to say to my children that I went to an event and heard an inspirational leader that talked about goodness and peace and justice. Too many of our world leaders are preaching about building walls, closing borders, economic sanctions, about building empires for themselves to the detriment of the small fellow, about refusing safe port to a ship load of refugees etc.

There are a number of issues of church doctrine and practice that I believe need to be changed. That aside, I find something wholesome and true when I hear Pope Francis addressing some of the issues of our time. I feel it would do me good to hear it live, the same as my father was inspired by a similar event in his time.

I am conscious of a scramble for tickets but if possible myself and the two lads in the flat would really love to go.
