CHURCH & the FUTURE - FINDING A WAY FORWARD: The well worn phrase “we live in changing times” is certainly true of this present age. Major changes are taking place in the way people associate with their neighbours, in the way they connect with each other, in the way people respond to various happenings – like Covid and the War in Ukraine for example, changes the way we live.
