Big Congratulations and Thank You to the Salthill Branch of The Apostolic Works Society. 50 years ago a group of ladies in the parish formed a local branch, to help support Irish Missionaries in foreign lands by providing vestments, sacred vessels and financial support. Since then, they held weekly Workshop sessions, making thousands of vestments which missionaries brought to the Third world for use in the Liturgy . Running along side that activity the good ladies of the society have provided vestments and a "repair" service to Salthill Parish for which we are very grateful. 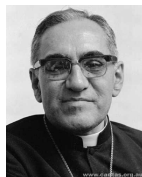
