The Season of Advent— Anticipation and Hope.

- Today we begin a new year in terms of Church Liturgy starting with 4 weeks of preparation for Christmas — with the season of Advent This season is full of joy, for it looks forward to the coming of the Lord. *Advent invites us to think some new thoughts, imagine new projects, and focus our basic options at the start of a the Church's year of worship. We renew our welcome to Jesus as the anchor of our lives, and prepare for his return at the end of time. Advent is an open invitation to make a new start in our personal spiritual journey.*

The word "Advent" itself means "coming".

During this season three comings of the Lord are referred to:

- ◆ first his coming as a human being at Bethlehem,
- ◆ secondly, his coming into the hearts of all believers on a daily basis
- ◆ and thirdly his coming in glory at the end of time.

The Advent wreath is a popular symbol of the beginning of the Church year. The circle of the wreath reminds us of God Himself. His eternity and endless mercy, which has no beginning or end. The green of the wreath speaks of the hope that we have in God, the hope of newness, of renewal, of eternal life.

Candles symbolise the light of God coming into the world through the birth of His Son. The four outer candles represent the period of waiting during the four Sundays of Advent, Then on Christmas Day the larger white candle is lit - "The Light has come in to the world."
