I was thinking !!

Dear Fellow Traveller

Two weeks ago we had the Pope at Mass in the Phoenix Park saying "Sorry" on behalf of the church to those people who were abused or wronged by either individual members of the church or by the institution itself. Earlier this week we have Mary Lou McDonald of Sinn Fein making an apology to Maria Cahill and others hurt or let down by individual Sinn Fein members or by the organisation itself. As I write this I read of apology from the HSE to those let down in relation to Cervical Cancer tests etc. Next week it will be some other group. When we do wrong, it's right to sincerely apologise and put right the wrong if possible. The recognition that I have been wronged is helpful in the healing process. The establishment of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission in South Africa is credited with greatly assisting in the establishment of a proper democracy in that country for example. A wrong needs to be recognised. Sometimes it is not possible to right a wrong.

On the flip side of the "Apology coin" is the concept of "Forgiveness" - easy to talk about, often very hard to do. Yet for healing to happen "Forgiveness" is essential. We must remember that forgiveness is not a Feeling, it is a "Decision" - "I want to forgive". There comes a stage when it is time to let go of past wrongs and get on with Living the Life we have as best and as full as possible. The prayer "Lord, Help me to ACCEPT the Things I cannot Change,

To CHANGE the things I can,
and the WISDOM to know the Difference".

is very true. As my Granny used to say - "The Past is over - there is no Future in it! Who ever said life was fair?" Jesus himself had a lot of trouble in this life and ended up being executed!

We need to learn from the past and get on with life where we are at. Life is tough enough without having to carry past hurts as well. The First Step in Getting somewhere, is to decide you are not going to stay where you are.
