There's a story about this philosopher who some years ago who had to make a long train journey of several hundred miles.

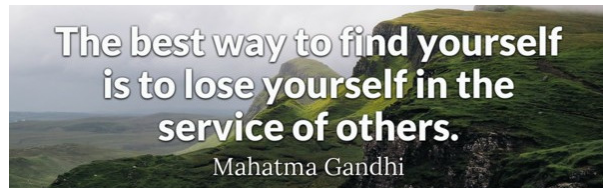
At the end of the journey the conductor proudly informed him that on this particular trip they had clipped six minutes from the previous journey. The Philosopher then enquired back.
