Dear Fellow Traveller,

Came upon a piece attributed to Steve Jobs, founder of the Apple Computer Empire who died last year of cancer. He was said to be worth 7 billion dollars. These words written towards the end of a person's life are poignant.

"In other eyes, my life is the essence of success, but aside from work, I have a little joy, and in the end wealth is just a fact of life to which I am accustomed.
