I was thinking ..... !

Dear Fellow Traveller,

**As we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi I invite you to stretch your minds and try to recapture the original intent of the Feast, and to hear the challenge that this feast presents to us today.**

**WHAT WAS THAT INTENT?**

It was that Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ, refers to the whole people of God, the congregation, the gathering of the community of faith. The people are the Body of Christ. And one exists for the sake of the other. In other words, the reason that Jesus is the Body of Christ in the Eucharist is that we might be the Body of Christ in our world. To put it another way: the Jesus-presence in the Eucharist is for the sake of the Jesus-presence in the world through us. They are interconnected. And when we forget that we no longer really remember what it is about.

So let's state the original thought again: as Jesus nourishes us with his body and blood in the Eucharist, we are to nourish the world with our body and blood. The Real Presence in the Eucharist exists to make us the Real Presence in the world. If you break that connection, you wind up with empty in-house piety and the absence of Jesus' mission in the world.

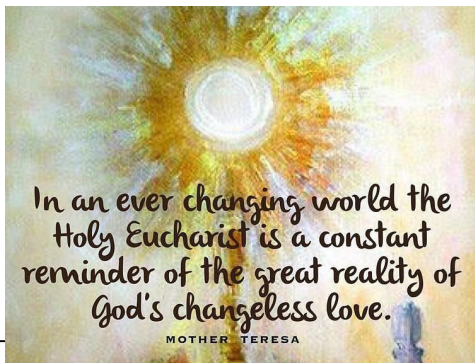
The challenge of this feast day is

- How can we become a Eucharistic People ?*

Maybe the prayer of St Theresa should inspire us;

*“Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours.”*
