It would be great if we could have a few more volunteers who would be willing to help "regulate the traffic" on a rota basis. We continue to record phone numbers for tracing purposes should the need arise.

It's against our nature to turn people away from church but when capacity is reached we are obliged to close the doors. Should that happen to you a suggestion is that you return to your car and "attend" Mass on the "live web cam" on your phone - www.salthillparish.ie and come in to church for Holy Communion after Mass has concluded. Big Thanks to all for your co-operation and patience .
