## SCATTERED THOUGHTS !



Dear Fellow Traveller,

The influence on our modern world of “Zoom meetings”, instant “Social media”, “Twitter”, “Facebook”, “What’s App” etc. is enormous. Often “truth” and “balanced comment” can take a bashing in the rush to judgement, and the hurt to the individual can be enormous. In the use of modern global technology we need to be reminded that “The world exists for everyone, because all of us are born with the same dignity. Differences of colour, religion, talent, place of birth, ethnic origin, and many other factors cannot be used to justify the privilege or dominance of some over the rights of all. As a community we have an obligation to ensure every person lives in dignity and has sufficient opportunities for his or her integral development. (Para-phrased from Pope Francis.).

As we approach Easter we are reminded that Jesus died for all and we are all brothers and sisters. The current “row” about the distribution of vaccines is another blot on the copybook of equality as is the promotion of “Nationalism”, the expectation by some of “the right to privilege” and so on. To be sure there are complex political and economic challenges for our leaders to navigate and protagonists need to be generous in resolving issues but that “they all may be one” is still the target and goal and ultimate message of Easter .
