Welcome Back !

Dear Fellow Traveller,

From Monday May 10th people can gather for Mass again in their local church. We are delighted to be in a position to come together as a community again — to meet our God and to meet one another. We are herd animals and we need each other ; the song — *“People who need people are the luckiest people in the World”* comes to mind (Sherlie Bassey and Barbara Streisand etc.). With Covid still around, we need to do so safely. Initially gatherings will be limited. The important thing is that people are safe. We propose to re-open gently, and see how it goes.

The Protocol for our church will be basically the same as previously: Salthill Church can accommodate a maximum of 100 people at Mass (in two “Pods” - 50 in front half of the church and same at the back). Parishioners will need to **“Book a seat” for weekend Masses** and this can be done by phone (091-523413 (Office hours Mon-Friday) or in person by calling to the parish office. Masks need to be worn in church and “social distancing” needs to be observed. Holy Communion will be distributed at the end of Mass as people leave the church at front and back porch - (it’s the safest way). People are asked not to congregate in crowds or groups in the church courtyard after Mass and to observe “Social Distancing”, Names need to be recorded in the event of tracing should the need arise.

Can you help ? We need help from Parishioners who would act as Ushers (10minutes before and after Mass), who would “meet and greet” and show people to a designated seat etc. Secondly we need volunteers to help with cleaning and sanitation, (We have purchased our own machine to help).

General Info: There are restrictions on numbers at Weddings (50), Funerals (50), and Baptisms (10-12 with 2-3 Pods/households.) .

All our Ceremonies will of course continue to be available “On-line” - www. “salthillparish.ie”

Mass Times: Saturday evenings 5:30p.m. (Vigil) and Sundays 9:30 and 11am. Weekdays 10am.

We’ve had a hard time of it. All of us. For some a nightmare year, for others more than a little inconvenience and, for those in between, a mixed bag. But whatever about perspective – the glass being half full or half empty – there’s a real sense that at long last we’re moving in the right direction, and the vaccines are working.

“Opening” up of our society will be challenging and as a community we will need to “connect again” with our families, our neighbours, our “service providers” etc. As we do so, I believe there is a need to “Listen” to each other in a real way before we make pronouncements or Judgements or lasting decisions. Building Community and restructuring society to make life better for all is a mammoth task which we all need to be involved.
