Just a thought!

Give a thought to what's going on in your parish.

“The Gospel and Me.” Summary of meeting of Thursday 16th last. Meeting opened with a short reflection and a quiet moment. Then everyone was allowed time to read over the Gospel for the following Sunday. When ready we were invited to comment on what parts or lines that stood out for us.

The following points were made:

This was John the Baptist's commentary on Jesus' baptism.

The humility of John and his awareness of his mission.

John as a witness. The fact that John said twice “I do not know Him myself” raised some ideas for discussion. John was inspired, aware and in touch with “He who sent me”.

This enabled him to see and witness “that Jesus is the Chosen One of God”.

Moving on the group looked at what we might take from this interpretation.

How can we be more like John? Being humble, aware, listening, seeing clearly, open minded, prayerful, reflective and being able to forgive oneself and others. From this perspective we too might be witnesses to God's Spirit in the world.

“The Gospel and Me” is a space where a group of parishioners come together to reflect on the following Sunday's Gospel.

The gathering takes place in Galilee on Thursday morning at 10.45 am. The aim is to discover how the Word of God, as given in the Gospel, can enrich us in our daily lives. It's a space where everyone has something to offer. “Where two or more are gathered, there am I in their midst”.

All are welcome, just bring an open mind. While the above ad hoc summary to a meeting may seem short the process of exploring takes a little longer and is enjoyable. Meeting always ends at 12 noon. Those who participate have stated how the meeting opens the Gospel and scripture to new insights that continue to arise in the mind over the week. This then impacts on how we view the world.
