Today Salthill Parish Newsletter brings a world exclusive. Somewhere in the ancient ruins of what was the legal district of Jerusalem an interesting letter has been found. Read on...

To *Mr Isaac Cohen, Supt Director, New Cemetery, Eternity Hill, Jerusalem.*

Dear Mr Cohen,

I thank you for your assistance in facilitating the burial of the man Jesus of Nazareth last on Friday week at short notice. I refer to my hurried correspondence dated - (Good Friday) last. I am conscious that the Passover Holiday means that you were out of the Office and are probably only catching up on correspondence. So I instruct you to please ignore my previous letter and regard this communication alone as effective. In my letter of Friday before the Passover, I requested you to arrange that the garden cemetery plot marked out for me be assigned to Jesus of Nazareth. With that communication I enclosed the burial consent forms and formal approval of the Governor Pontius Pilate. It's possible that some processes of law weren't followed due to our haste with an immediate burial and the Festival approaching. The grave has now been vacated and is no longer required by Jesus of Nazareth. . However I will need it myself in time. If there is any confusion or legal doubt about this new arrangement, I am happy to assist. I regret any inconvenience and again thank you for your understanding on that Friday evening.

This is not a true letter archaeologically, but it could have been. The empty tomb isn't just a feeling or a myth - it is a fact. That's what we celebrate in faith at Easter time. Death does not have the final say— when all this life is folder up - We have a Future !

In Ireland our ancestors believed that the sun danced, and that nature celebrated on Easter Sunday because Jesus had risen from the dead. They used to go to the hilltops to see this spectacle. We continue to pray that we may be safe from the Coronavirus and that it may soon be overcome. Mother Teresa used to wake every morning and say - "Good morning Jesus, Now what have **We** got to do today." Then she swung her legs out of the bed and got on with life. We pray that we would do the same. "I arise with God, May God rise with me, God's hand about me as I sit, as I lie and as I rise. Amen".
